Staff's Recommended Action:

1. Introduce the item as an action item;

"I move that the SCC recommend the HCAOG Board approve the FY 2017-18 SB1 fund allocations."

Staff Summary:

On April 28, 2017, Governor Brown signed Senate Bill (SB) 1 known as the Road Repair and Accountability Act of 2017. SB1 will direct approximately \$250 million to the State Transit (STA) Program and \$105 million to the new State of Good Repair (SGR) Program annually.

The California State Controller's office FY 2017-18 funding estimate for the STA augmentation is \$347,718 in addition to \$211,444 for the SGR Program. The 2017-18 estimates are based on partial year funding. The amount will increase over time. On November 6, 2017, HCAOG staff disseminated a solicitation for these funds.

The formula distribution for the new funds is the same as the STA program. PUC 99313 allocations are based on population estimates from the Department of Finance. PUC section 99314 allocations are based on the qualifying revenues from annual reports. Third party contractors providing transportation services should coordinate with their respective city or the county to submit candidate projects.

The SGR Program has a specific goal of keeping transit systems in a state of good repair, including the purchase of new vehicles, and maintenance and rehabilitation of transit facilities and vehicles. SGR Guidelines detail roles and responsibilities for HCAOG and transit agencies requesting funds. At the time of programming, HCAOG staff will be recommending that the HCAOG Board limit allocating 99313 funds for the next fiscal year to any transit agency that does not comply with reporting requirements detailed in the guidelines.
