Staff Summary:

HCAOG in its role as the Humboldt County Service Authority for Freeway Emergencies (SAFE) is responsible for the road side call box program in Humboldt County. Funding for this program is obtained from a one-dollar registration fee collected by the Department of Motor Vehicles (California State Streets and Highways Code, Section 131.1, Sections 2550- 2559; and California Vehicle Code 9250.10).

Humboldt County's SAFE Program currently has a total of 62 call boxes for roadside emergencies distributed along SR 101 and SR 299. The attached report provides a three-month usage summary indicating which call boxes were used by the public and how many calls were made from each call box.
