5. Action Items

a. Safe Streets and Roads for All (SS4A) Consultant Recommendation

Motion was made (Mattson/Byrd) to forward a recommendation for the HCAOG Board's consideration to select Project Consultants SmithGroup to complete the Humboldt County Regional Vision Zero Action Plan.

Motion passed with Steven Pearl abstaining.

b. Regional Transportation Plan (RTP) Project Prioritization Ad Hoc Committee

Motion was made (Byrd/Khatri) to recommend that the HCAOG Board approve the formation of an Ad Hoc Committee that will explore opportunities to establish a policy for prioritizing transportation projects listed in the RTP and assist in leveraging outside funding. Ad Hoc Committee Members would include Tom Mattson, Catharine Crayne, Netra Khatri, Katie Collender, Noah Rodriguez, and Jesse Willor.

c. Federal Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (FSTIP) Carbon Reduction Program Call for Projects
