6. Action Items

a. Transportation Development Act Article 3, Bicycle and Pedestrian 2% Allocation Requests

Motion was made (Mattson/Khatri) to recommend that the HCAOG Board approve the Bicycle and Pedestrian 2% allocation requests in the amount of \$176,847 for projects for City of Arcata, City of Blue Lake, City of Eureka, and City of Ferndale.

7. Discussion Items

a. Draft Methodology for the Level of Traffic Stress (LTS) Assessments for Local Streets and Roads

Oona Smith, HCAOG Senior Regional Planner, and Colin Fiske of the Coalition for Responsible Transportation Priorities presented the draft proposed methodology for the LTS assessment and received input from the TAC.

b. Safe Streets and Roads for All Grant Update

Associate Regional Planner, Stevie Luther, provided an update on the Safe Streets and Roads for All Project and received input from the TAC.

8. HCAOG Executive Director and Staff Reports

Executive Director Beth Burks discussed the following:

- Bike Month has wrapped up and was successful. HCAOG has been handing out helmets to the public.
- The photoshoot for the TIRCP/HTA grant was a busy but successful week.
- ATP funding is in flux while the state budget is being revised. Several other funding sources have also been disrupted.

9. TAC Member Reports

- Tom Mattson reminded the TAC that the HSIP application is open and there is significant funding available. The County will be presenting a proposed tax at upcoming city council meetings.
- Jesse Willor shared that the City of Eureka's Bike Master Plan will be going to City Council in the next couple of months.

- Katie Collender shared that HTA is offering free rides for seniors and youth on all HTA systems through August 31st.
- Saskia Rymer-Burnett shared that Greyhound has discontinued service from Arcata to San Francisco. Mendocino Transit Authority is hosting a North State Transit Symposium on July 10th in Ukiah.
