 - The draft FY 2025-26 Sustainable Transportation Planning Grant application guide is still available for comments until Thursday, October 10th. There will be two workshops on October 16th and 17th which will provide stakeholders with the comment summary, anticipated updates, and final input options. The finalized grant guide will be released later in the month.
 - O District 1 staff will be hosting a grant application workshop, dates and location TBD.
 - o The 5th Annual Research to Practice Symposium will take place virtually on October 22nd -24th.
