Staff's Recommended Action:

"I move that the SSTAC recommend the HCAOG Board make the following appointments to the SSTAC: Peggy Martinez as the representative of potential transit users with a disability and Carol Moné as a public representative for the Coalition for Responsible Transportation Priorities."

AND

"I move that the SSTAC authorize the Chair to write a Notice of Termination to the HCAOG Board recommending the Board take action to terminate Gavin Smiley and to terminate the seat for the Blue Lake Rancheria Transit System from the SSTAC."

Staff Summary:

Two candidates are seeking appointments to the SSTAC. Per the SSTAC by-laws section 4.02, individuals that are non-agency members need to complete an application. The SSTAC should review the applications and make a recommendation to the HCAOG Board for appointing action. Staff recommends the appointment of both candidates as both individuals are knowledgeable

about public transit and transportation issues and have demonstrated commitment to public service. The following interest statements are provided as the application for membership.

Staff reached out to Blue Lake Rancheria, and they confirmed they will no longer be using their agency seat on the SSTAC. Removing the seat will assist with meeting quorums. The bylaws section 4.07 states that a member is removed effective on the date that the HCAOG Board approves, in a public meeting, a written Notice of Termination from the SSTAC Chair.

As an informational point unrelated to these action items, agency members can rotate out of the position with a formal appointing action of a replacement agency by the HCAOG Board (per Section 4.06 of the Bylaws). We would want to have the new agency selected prior to the other stepping down.
