Staff's Recommended Action:

“I move that the TAC recommend the HCAOG Board approve the Bicycle and Pedestrian 2% allocation requests as discussed by the TAC”

Staff Summary:

Pursuant to HCAOG's adopted Rules and Regulations for the Administration of the Transportation Development Act, 2% of the available Transportation Development Act (TDA)

Local Transportation Funds (LTF) is set aside for the exclusive use of projects aiding bicyclists and pedestrians. The available allocation this year is \$155,381.

Fifty percent of the yearly allocation was previously reserved in a set-aside fund intended for use if at any time an urgent regional priority projects come up. The reserve is now fully funded at \$500,000.

Four TDA claimants requested funds this year. The total funding request is \$291,375 which is \$135,994 above the available allocation amount. The funding requests are summarized below, and the full requests are included with this staff report:
