RESOLUTION 21-26
RESOLUTION OF THE HUMBOLDT COUNTY ASSOCIATION OF GOVERNMENTS,
ACTING AS THE SERVICE AUTHORITY FOR FREEWAY EMERGENCIES,
AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF A STANDARD AGREEMENT
WITH THE CALIFORNIA HIGHWAY PATROL
FOR SUPPLEMENTAL PATROLS ON STATE ROUTES 36, 96 AND 169

WHEREAS, the Humboldt County Association of Governments (HCAOG), in its official capacity as the designated Service Authority for Freeway Emergencies, hereinafter called SAFE, provides for the implementation, maintenance and operation of a motorist-aid roadside call box system for the citizens of Humboldt County; and

WHEREAS, HCAOG has continued a contractual relationship for services and assistance with the California Highway Patrol (CHP) in accordance with the “CHP/Caltrans Call Box and Motorist Aid Guidelines” since the inception of Humboldt County’s roadside call box program in 1994; and

WHEREAS, there is a need for supplemental patrols on State Routes 36, 96 and 169, highways with limited cell phone coverage; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to enter into a Standard Agreement with the CHP not to exceed \$100,000 effective September 1, 2021 through October 31, 2022 for supplemental patrols on State Routes 36, 96, and 169.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that HCAOG’s Executive Director be authorized to execute a Standard Agreement with the CHP not to exceed \$100,000 for the period effective November 1, 2021 through October 31, 2022 for supplemental patrol services on State Routes 36, 96, and 169.
